Role	Friendship and Conversation Volunteer (with Afghan Women's Group)
Purpose	To offer New Scots an opportunity to connect with others, spend time in meaningful way, get to know Edinburgh, learn new things, and practise English.
Specific Tasks	 Meeting and greeting participants as they arrive for the activity Supporting participants during activities Offering an opportunity to practise English in a relaxed, informal environment Helping with setting up an activity and with tidying up Supporting group outings to different locations in Edinburgh Attending and contributing to debriefs after each session to identify concerns, successes and areas for development in terms of our delivery of sessions
Skills and Qualities	Commitment to inclusive working, interest in supporting others, good listening and interpersonal skills, patience, reliability and flexibility, respect for other cultures, interest in developing your skills and reflecting on experiences. Additionally, sewing, knitting or art & craft skills which volunteer could share with participants would be a great bonus, but it is not essential.
